## Fingerless Mittens

Knit in Lion Brand Superbulky

### Materials

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Set of 4 dpn's 6.5mm (US 10.5)  
Super Bulky Weight Yarn (Cat 6) -  
One Skein (less than 100 yds)  
2 Stitch Markers

### SKILLS REQUIRED:

Cast On, Bind Off

Knit In-the-Round

Knit ("k")

Make 1 ("m1")\*

## Project Overview

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Quick and satisfying, this simple set of fingerless mittens is perfect for knitters learning to knit-in-the-round, knitting up last minutes gifts, and using up leftovers. The mittens are knit from wrist to fingers and includes a simple, built-in thumb. There is NO right or left mitten, you'll simply knit two.

Using extra bulky yarn, here is where your striped and variegated colorways come to life. Or use your favorite color to give any outfit a colorful, yet minimalist appeal with a super chunky look.

## Sizes

One size fits most women.

Increase needle size for larger sizes.

# Let's Get Started

Cast on 21 stitches and spread stitches among the three needles (7 st each).

Join in-the-round, ensuring you don't twist the stitches.

ROUNDS 1-12: knit all rounds

**THUMB** (beginning at start of round):

ROUND 13: k7, k3, **place marker**, **k1**, **place marker**, knit to end of round

ROUND 14: k10, **slide marker**, **m1**, **k1**, **m1**, **slide marker**, knit to end of round

ROUND 15: knit all stitches

ROUND 16: k10, **slide marker**, **m1**, **k3**, **m1**, **slide marker**, knit to end of round

ROUND 17: knit all stitches

ROUND 18: k10, **slide marker**, **m1**, **k5**, **m1**, **slide marker**, knit to end of round

ROUND 19: knit all stitches

ROUND 20: k10, **slide marker**, **m1**, **k7**, **m1**, **slide marker**, knit to end of round

### MAKE 1 ("m1")

The increases for the thumb take place between the stitch markers - just after the first marker and again before the second.

The stitch is made by picking up a "bar" (between with the left and right needle) FROM THE BACK FORWARD, then knitting it through the front loop as you would a regular knit stitch.



(continued)

ROUND 21: knit to first marker, **bind off the 9 stitches** between the markers, removing the markers as you go, knit to end of round. (**NOTE:** You should now have SIX stitches on Needle 2)

ROUND 22: knit to thumb gusset, pick up ONE STITCH from bind-off row (near the right working needle) for a nice tight thumb joint, then continue to knit all stitches to the end of round

ROUNDS 23 thru 30: knit all rounds

Bind off all stitches and weave end ends on the wrong side of work. Repeat for second mitten.



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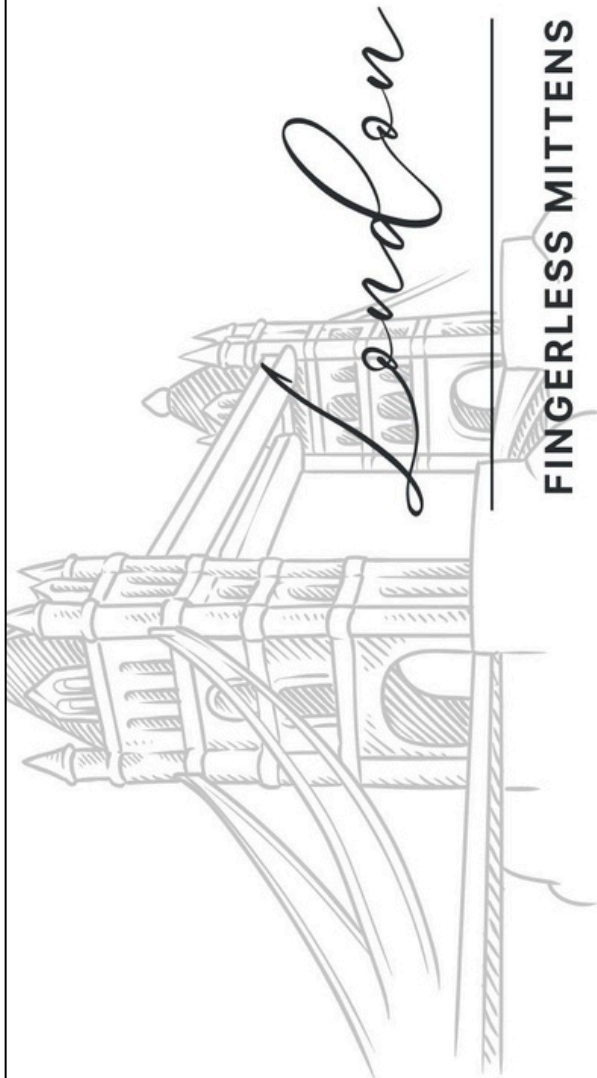
## Using Bulky Yarn (Cat5)

The mitten can be modified to accommodate Bulky (Cat 5) weight yarn with the following adjustments:

- CAST ON 24 stitches - 8 stitches each needle
- Place the STITCH MARKERS after stitches 4 and 6 (stitches 5 & 6 are between the markers)
- INCREASE THE THUMB to a total of 10 stitches, casting them off on the next row
